To link text on a page to another wiki page, be sure you are first in "Edit" mode.

## Option 1: Using the "Add Link" Button


You can link one wiki page to another by using the "Add Link" button on your tool bar. Simply select the text you would like to link to the file, then click the "Add Link" button. You can select the correct file by either entering the name of the page, web address, or file and hitting return, OR you can click "Browse Pages & Files" and locate the file there.

## Option 2: Using "Insert Links"

First, highlight the text you want linked, and second, find the name of the page under the "Insert links" heading and on the "Pages" tab. The highlighted text is linked if it now has a line under it.



Be sure to save your changes before leaving the page.
